HOW DO WE OPERATE?

We provide secondary tuition from Grades 8 to 12. Our students are registered as homeschoolers. All Grades 8 and 9 students follow the Cambridge IGCSE curriculum. (We have found that this curriculum provides a very strong foundation for the higher grades.) At the end of grade 9, the students may choose to do the National Senior Certificate curriculum for grades 10, 11, and 12. This curriculum is provided by Impaq, which collates the tasks, orals, exams, and reports of the homeschoolers. Alternatively, the Grade 9 students may choose to continue with the International General Certificate of Secondary Education administered by Cambridge, which is equivalent to Grade 10. Thereafter they follow the AS (A level Subsidiary) Cambridge curriculum for two years, writing their finals at the end of Grade 12. Cambridge qualifications are administered by Cambridge International Assessment and Education and, consequently, accepted by most international universities, as well as by South African universities. Thus Cambridge qualifications provide students with a greater opportunity for tertiary study abroad.

School Fees

*New students pay **R2,000.00** on registration: **R1,000.00** administration costs + **R1,000.00** incidental costs such as visits to museums and expos.

*Existing students pay **R1,000.00** per annum to cover incidental costs such as visits to museums and expos.

*Monthly fees for Cambridge students: **R4,000.00** for **12** months of the year.

*All internal exam costs are included in this fee. The external Cambridge exam fees at the end of Grade 10 (IGCSE) and Grade 12 (AS) are payable to Cambridge.

*Monthly fees payable to The Tuition Centre for CAPS students: **R3,000.00**.

*Fees payable to Impaq either in a lump sum of approximately **R40,000.00** for the year or by means of a deposit of about **R16,000.00** plus **12** monthly payments of about **R2,000.00**. This fee includes all books, study guides, facilitators guides, plus all tests and exams.

*On registration, parents should arrange a debit order in favour of The Tuition Centre for their fees.
